

Local Service Centers provide specialized prevention services and programs to youth in Alameda County who are system-involved, or at risk of becoming system-involved. Common reasons for referral include habitual truancy, running away from home, trouble with law enforcement, engaging in high-risk behaviors, and being beyond parental control.

The seven Local Service Centers specialize in offering programs in one or more of the five categories: Diversion, Life Skills, Civic and Social Engagement, Restorative Justice, and Mentoring.

Local Service Centers provide services and programs to youth referred by a variety of Alameda County sources, including, but not limited to the following:


- Probation Department
