

Youth Service Centers provide prevention services to youth in Alameda County who are system-involved, or at risk of becoming system-involved. Common reasons for referral include habitual truancy, running away from home, trouble with law enforcement, engaging in high-risk behaviors, and being beyond parental control.

Services for youth and their families include, but are not limited to: therapeutic counseling, crisis intervention, case management, diversion and truancy mediation.

Youth Service Centers provide services and programs to youth referred by a variety of Alameda County sources, including, but not limited to the following:


- Crisis Receiving Home
