

## Board Supervisor Richard Valle

It is with great sadness that we inform you of the passing of Supervisor Richard Valle. He passed away peacefully on Wednesday afternoon after a two-year battle with prostate-cancer. He is survived by his wife of 44 years, his daughter, son and 3 grandchildren.

Richard Valle was a friend to Probation, a leader that understood and valued the work that we do for our clients and the greater community. Since 2012, he held the position of Chair of the Public Protection Committee, that encompassed Probation and other public safety entities. He held our mutual goal of keeping our communities safe and working tirelessly to create a safe place for us to be as individuals. He leaves a strong legacy as a committed and accessible representative of our-his community.



Supervisor Valle attended Chabot College and received a bachelor's degree and an MPA from California East Bay. He was an U.S. Army Medic, serving in the Vietnam War in 1970. He founded the Tri-CED Community, a nonprofit recycling organization. In 1997, he served on the Union City Council through 2010 and was a long-time resident of Union City and Sunol. In 2012, he was elected to represent Alameda County's District 2, which encompasses the cities of Hayward, Union City, Newark, and sections of Fremont. He ran unchallenged for his last term and was sworn into office on the 17th of January 2023 working until the very end.
