ALAMEDA COUNTY CRISIS RECEIVING HOME

The Crisis Receiving Home (CRH) is a same-day emergency shelter that provides a safe environment for **youth ages 8 through 17** who are in crisis. The shelter is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year. At the CRH, youth receive:

- Three healthy meals a day
- Comfortable sleeping accommodations
- Hygiene supplies
- Educational and recreation activities
- Family counseling and reunification services
- Case management and therapy

Notes: The CRH accepts same-day drop-offs from law enforcement officers. Officers should first obtain consent from the youth's legal guardian (while keeping the location and telephone number of the CRH confidential) and call the CRH to ensure there is space available. Youth are NOT eliqible for services if they are on probation or in foster care.


*Local law enforcement should be called to arrange for more immediate and safe transport to the CRH. This is a secure location whose address is not be disclosed to the public.
