What does a Clinical Supervisor do?

They are licensed clinician positions and provide support to clinical staff and they also carry a small caseload.

Can the youth see a therapist seven days a week, 24 hours/day? Yes, the unit clinicians can provide 1:1 support.

How does ACBH identify the 90-day window for CalAIM for re-entry support?

We are working with probation to make a plan. The goal is to keep youth connected to a provider. ACBH is working to be in compliance with DHCS policies with the goal of approval by 2026.

It was requested that ACBH provide an update at the next meeting about community support coming into the SYTF.

Are the PREA requirements still the same?

Yes, they are the same. However, the classes are now available online.
