

Alameda County SB 823 Subcommittee Workgroups

Suggested division & composition

Education, Vocational Training, & Reentry

Workgroup should discuss the skills, education, training, & treatment that will support the successful reentry & family/community reintegration of youth. ACPD holds that successful reentry planning begins as soon after intake as possible. Attention should be paid to continuity of resources and treatment as well. Probation staff will participate in this workgroup to provide information on current operations, re-entry processes, etc. as needed or requested by the workgroup.

Mental Health, Specialized Treatment, & Family Engagement

Workgroup should focus on mental health treatment, both clinical & pre-clinical. This workgroup should discuss trauma & ACEs, and will also discuss sex behavior treatment programs, the needs of those with serious mental illnesses, as well as gender-responsive programming. Family engagement is included here as many mental health treatments and supports will likely involve family members (although the consideration & discussion of family engagement should be broad and go beyond mental health treatment involvement). Probation staff will participate in this workgroup to provide information on current services and family engagement activities as needed or requested by the workgroup.

Core Programming & Facilities

This workgroup will be discussing a wide range of topics related to core programming that most, if not all, youth will potentially engage in. This should include recreation & other electives, as well as broad foundational programming values and approaches, such as restorative justice principles, culturally relevant programming, and trauma informed practices. This workgroup will also consider the needs of the youth with regards to programming & the facilities that would best accommodate those programs. This will require listening closely to other programming space needs as reported out by other workgroups as well. The discussion should include broad discussion of recommendations for facilities considerations moving forward. Probation staff will participate in this workgroup to provide information on current programming, facilities operations, etc. as needed or requested by the workgroup.
