Part 5 of Phase A Draft Plan

- Facility Plan
 - Plans to use existing JJC facility
- ACPD has requested additional funds for facility renovations/enhancements to make SB823 unit more therapeutic
- Section also outlines incentive, therapeutic adjustments, & sanctions plan to encourage positive behavior
- Outlines appeals & grievances process for youth

Part 6 of Phase A Draft Plan

- Retaining target population in the Juvenile Justice System
 - As opposed to waiver/transfer to adult system
- ACPD plans to continue existing tools & policies to minimize transfer
 - Staff responsible for transfer hearing reports receive additional training
 - **All** cases with potential removal from community (including transfer cases) reviewed by SOS committee
 - Committee shows success in reducing out of home placements & RED in OOH placements

Part 7 of Phase A Draft Plan

- Regional Efforts
 - ACPD intends to develop MOUs w/ a regional county to support needs of:
 - Girls
 - High level sex offender treatment
 - Intensive mental health treatment

Part 8 of Phase A Draft Plan

- Data
 - ACPD has robust data collection system
 - Also has internal Research & Evaluation Unit
 - Committed to collecting & analyzing both quantitative & qualitative data
 - Outcome measures, including youth participation & satisfaction
 - Committed to RED analyses to ensure equity in treatment & programming
