OVERVIEW:

- 10 beds available for ACPD (men and women allowed)
- Single Occupancy—everyone gets their own room (each room has its own sink; community bathrooms)
- 6-month duration
- Dinner delivered daily
- No curfew

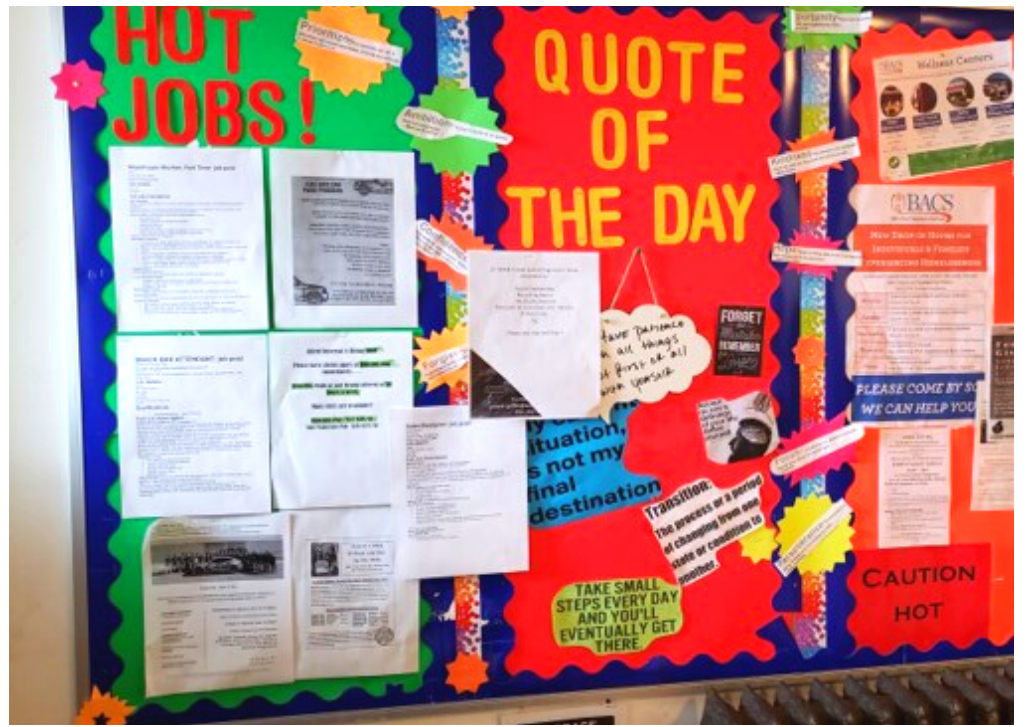
PROGRAM INFORMATION:

- Case management services; Goals are to help individuals increase income/benefits, develop life skills, access to health care, finding permanent housing
- Rooms are fully furnished; outside belongings are limited to what can fit inside drawers and designated storage space
- No overnight guests/visitors
- Smoking allowed in designated spot (on property)
- Less than 1 mile from downtown Oakland; near several major bus lines and less than a mile from 3 main BART stations
- Laundry services free and onsite

OVERVIEW:

- 16 beds available for ACPD (men only)
- Clean and sober living
- 24/7 On-site staff to help assist with any issues
- Shared housing units (roommate)
- Transportation services available
- Laundry services free and onsite

PROGRAM INFORMATION:

- Rooms come fully furnished; each person gets own bed, 1 locker, and 2 full-sided drawers
- Outside belongings are limited to what can fit inside drawers and designated storage space
- Easy access to public transportation—right off of major bus lines, less than 2 miles from BART station

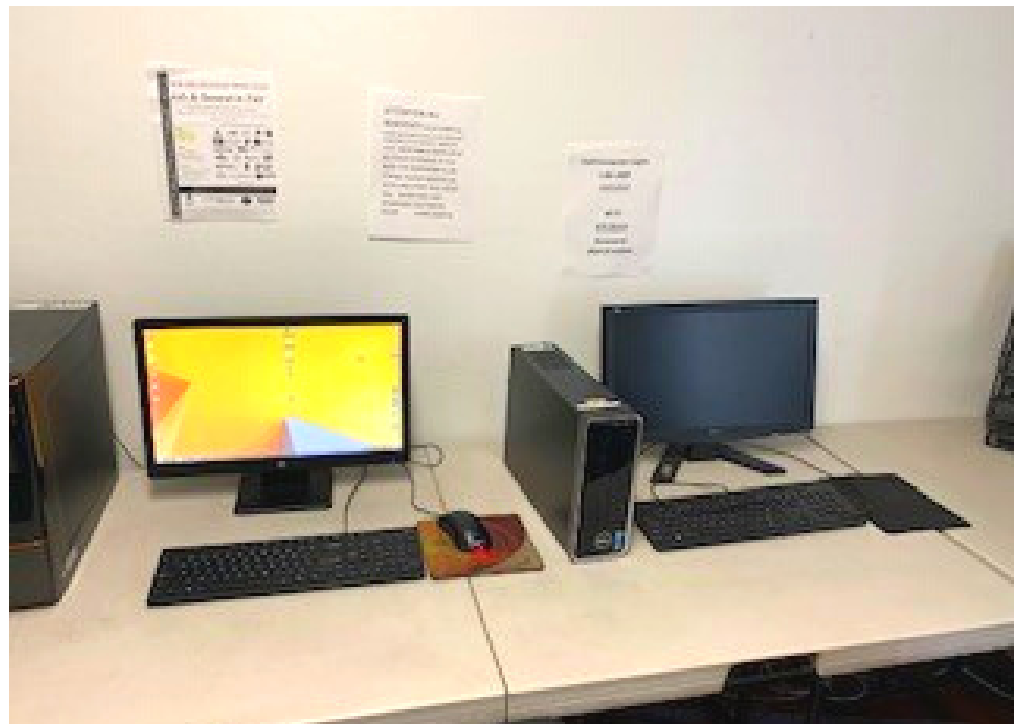

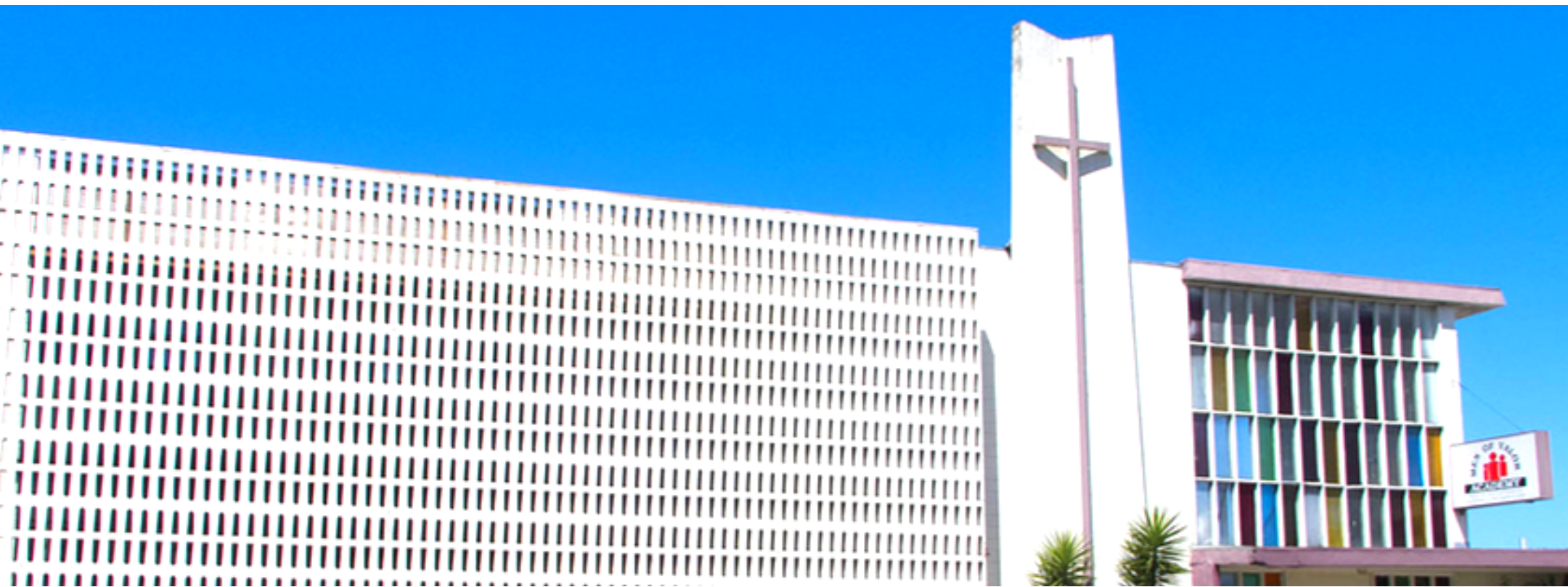

- Case management with goals to focus on job training, employment, substance abuse assistance and permanent housing placement
- Dormitory Housing Model (bunkbeds in large rooms)
- Easy access to public transportation—right off 2 major bus lines, less than 2 miles from BART station
- Two vans for transportation services
- Visitors in common areas only (not in rooms)
- Laundry services free and onsite

- Eastmont location; near several major bus lines and less than 2 miles from BART Station

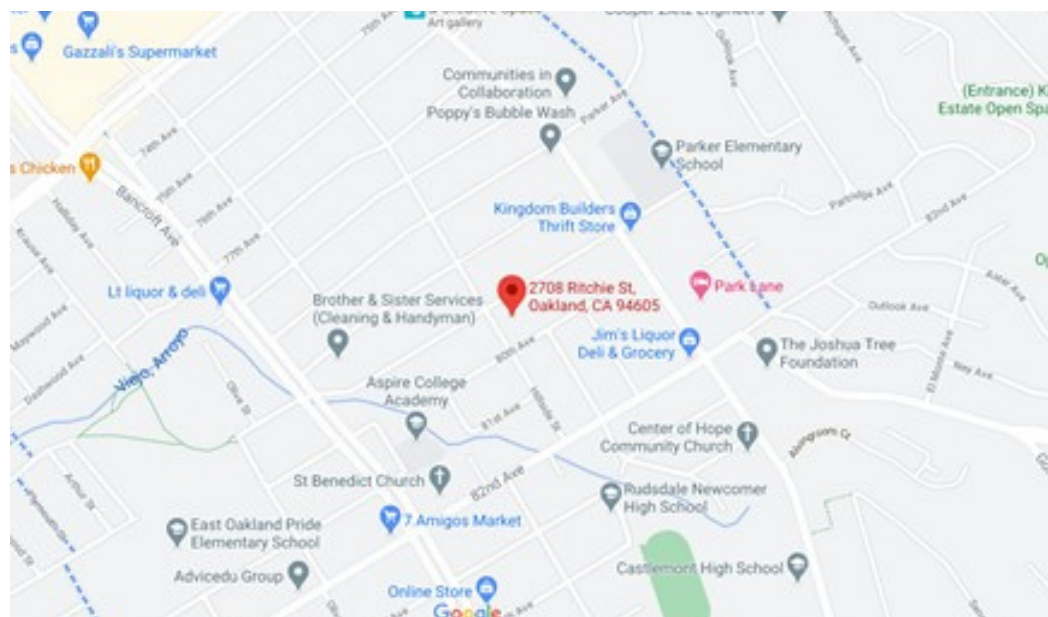

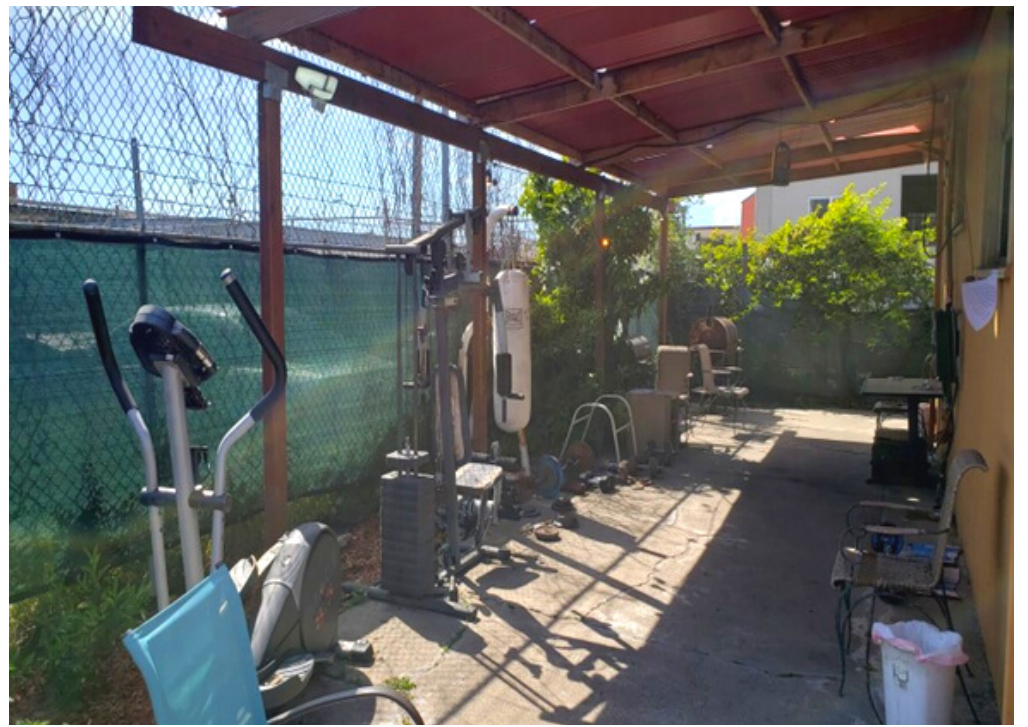

- Smoking only offsite

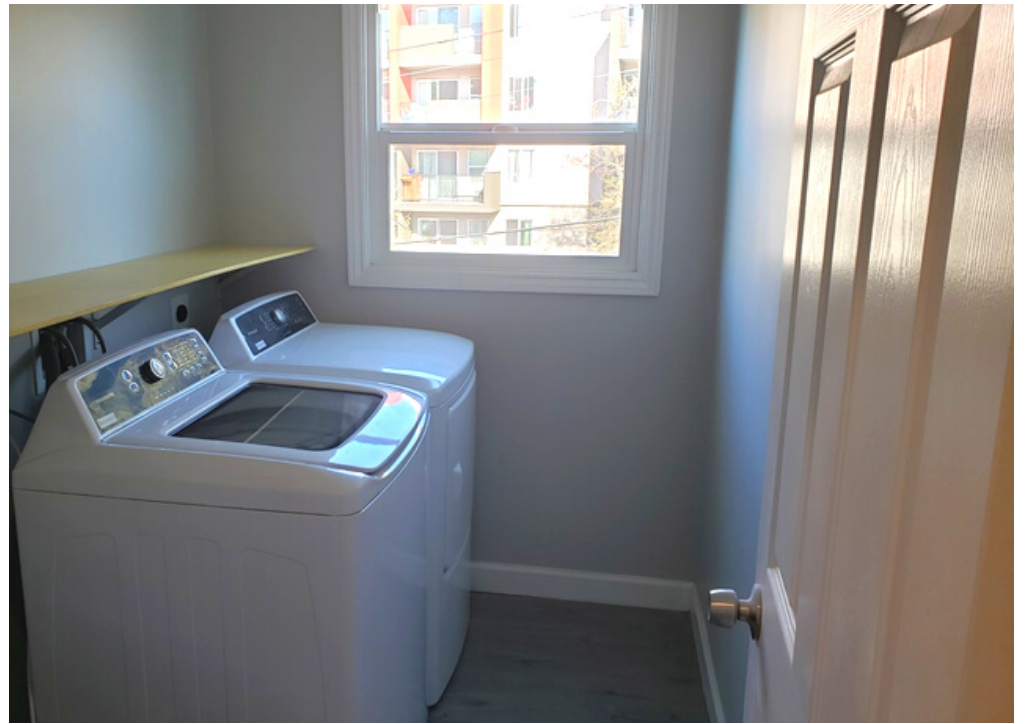
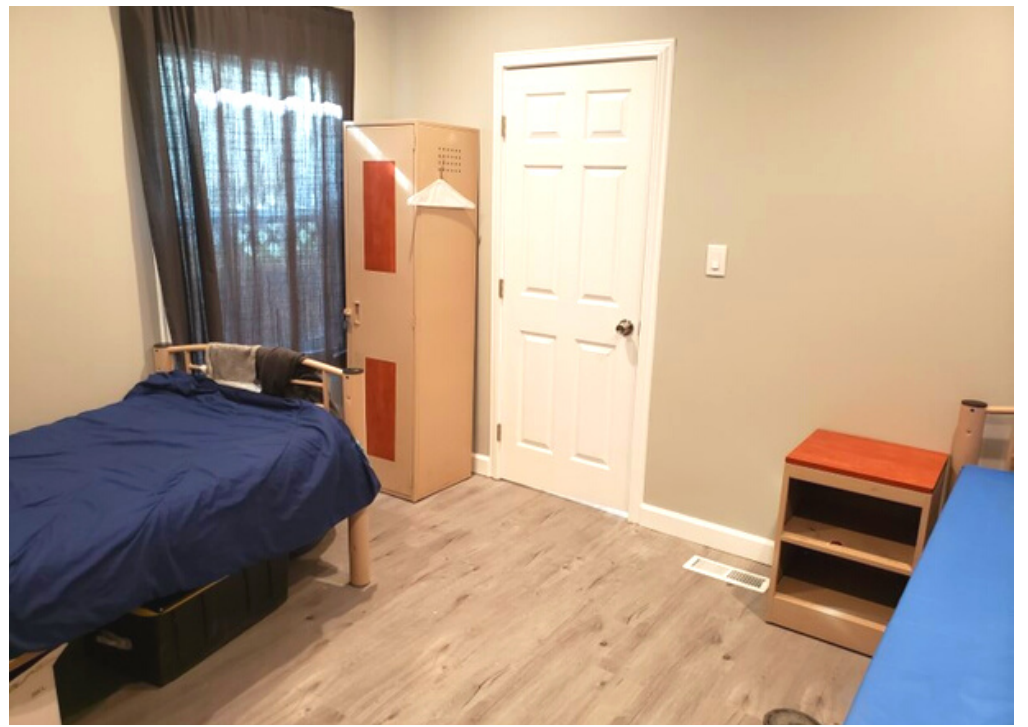
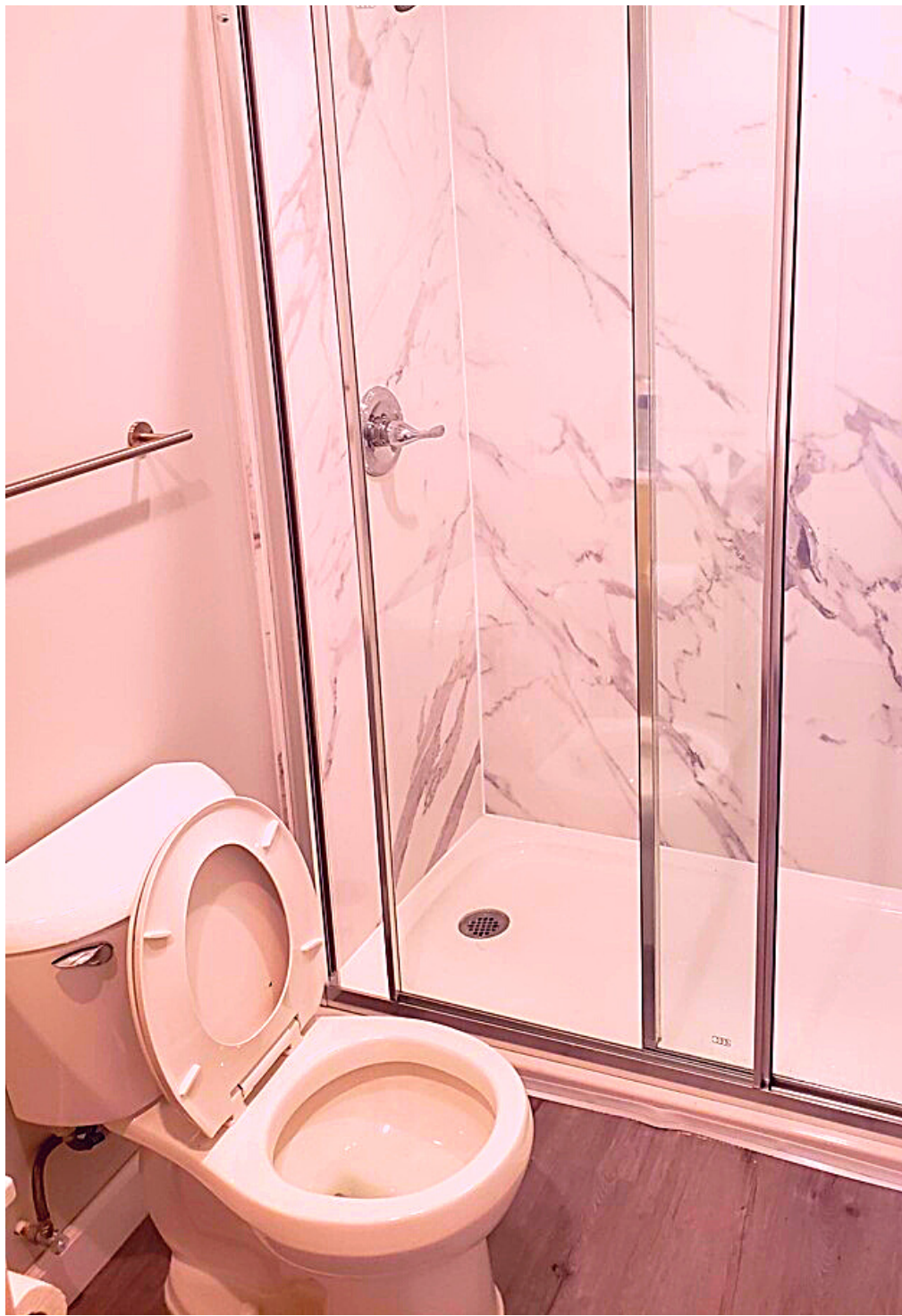
